# FOUND HOUSE IHN

July 2023

Continuing our partnership of over **30 years** supporting families served by Found House Interfaith Housing Network, Wise Temple served as a shelter, welcoming, housing, and feeding four Cincinnati families. Wise Temple congregants turned classrooms into bedrooms, playing with children, making and donating food and toiletries, and creating community with families.



# CRAYONS TO COMPUTERS

August 2023

Along with delivering the back-to-school items generously donated by the Wise Temple community, volunteers were put to work sorting donated supplies, including backpacks, envelopes, crayons, and colored pencils. To date, Crayons to Computers has distributed more than **\$184 million** worth of free school supplies, enhancement, and incentive items to greater Cincinnati schools.

On a single night alone, Women of Wise (along with friends from Rockdale and Valley Temples) gathered to write and address **400 postcards** in support of Issue 1 to be sent to Ohio voters.



# SWEET CHEEKS

November 2023

Helping to support the organization's mission to provide free diapers to low-income families, generous members of Wise Temple came together to wrap **7,812 diapers**, enough to serve **156 babies** for a month.





# HIGH HOLY

## YOM KIPPUR MITZVAH BAG PROJECT

The Wise Temple community continued its incredible generosity through the Yom Kippur Mitzvah Bag project again this year. Whether you “carried the mitzvah” by bringing in bags of donated items, or “clicked the mitzvah” by sending countless Amazon boxes through online donations, we are so grateful for your support. In the end, the congregation donated approximately **12,500 pounds** of food – the equivalent of **10,200 meals** – to the Freestore Foodbank. In nearly four decades, Wise Temple has now donated approximately **743,600 pounds** of food (nearly 372 tons!) to the Freestore Foodbank.

## ROSH HASHANAH TEEN EXPERIENCE: NEW YEAR, NEW WORLD SERVICE PROJECT, SUPPORTING HEARTFELT TIDBITS

18 Wise Temple teens came together to celebrate Rosh Hashanah, learn about the core themes of the Shofar service, and help create a world with more mercy. Partnering with Heartfelt Tidbits, Wise Temple teens decorated bags and filled them with books to give to refugee families arriving in Cincinnati. By providing over **200 books** to help refugee children learn to read English, our community helped welcome and support these families as they become part of the community.

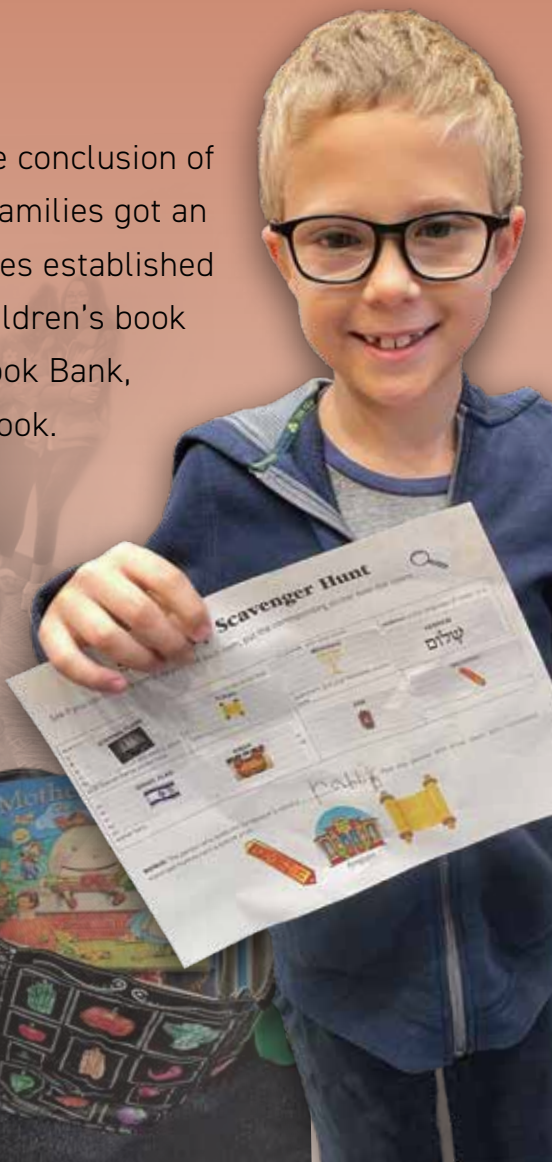
